- (N) Scabbards.
- (P) Cots.

2. Krag bayonets should be designated as 'KL', Russian bayonets as 'RL', Winchester bayonets as 'WL'.

3. Sample of telegram to be used, i. e. "'K' one hundred received 'R' and 'RL' fifty in transit 'M' and 'N' and 'P' no." Sign as prescribed.
